Manchester College is 14th as a "Best College" in the Midwest, reports one of the premier rankings in the nation, *U. S. News & World Report*. Manchester also continues its coveted Best Value status in the magazine's annual "America's Best Colleges" edition.

Close connections between faculty and students helped raise Manchester 6 places in the 2008 rankings. The magazine noted Manchester's 14:1 student-faculty ratio, its small class sizes (57 percent are less than 20 students), and that 92 percent of MC faculty members hold the highest degree in their field. ... more >
